

Peru

Located in the west central part of South America, Peru will be sure to bring out the hidden adventurer in you! You will be amazed by Peru's vast geography, its flora and fauna, its rich culture and its diverse people. Known for its beauty and richness, Lima, Peru's capital, is a city full of contrasts: a large modern city where Indian, African, European and Asian cultures blend. The different migrations that have taken place along the centuries give the people a unique and special sense of hospitality especially with foreign visitors. Lima's colonial architecture is reflected in important buildings such as The Government Palace, the Cathedral, houses of nobles and dozens of churches, all of which are proven examples of Peru's cultural, artistic and religious richness.

Travel towards Cuzco. Acknowledged as an energy and spiritual centre, this city is wrapped in time, magic and mystery. The archaeological remains prove that several pre-Inca civilisations gave birth to this city, the Wari culture being one of the most important ones. On their arrival, the Spanish conquerors built their homes over many of the existing temples creating in this way an extraordinary mixture of cultures and religions. In Cuzco and its surroundings are the most important ruins of the area such as Ollantaytambo, Sacsahuaman, Puca Pucara and especially Machu Picchu, one of the most beautiful and renowned archaeological sites on the planet. These magnificent ruins that are also known as the 'Lost City of the Incas' are every bit as magical as you have heard. The ancient lost stone city, nestled high in the mountains, is often bathed in misty, gauzy clouds that make it seem even more mysterious and alluring.







When to go

The weather varies according to area. On the coast winter lasts from June to September. During this period, the mountainous areas are often sunny during the day but cold at night. This is high tourist season and the best time to visit most regions.





Nasca Lines & Ballestas Islands Extension – 03 Days/02 Nights

The Nazca Lines, one of the greatest mysteries of mankind because of their curious appearance and purpose, are located on a large arid plain 2 hours from Paracas. These lines drawn in the middle of the desert form enormous figures of animals and objects, some of them the size of a football stadium. Their sizes have an incredible perfection and accuracy. The monkey, the humming bird, the spider and many other figures can only be seen from the sky from a light aircraft which is highly recommended!

The extension also visits the Ballestas Islands which are located just off the coast of the Paracas National Reserve, a UNESCO Natural World Heritage Site. You will visit by boat and view the marine and coastal fauna, including many types of birds, sea lions, Humboldt penguins and the occasional dolphin.

Day 02: Fly to Puerto Maldonado in the heart of the Amazon Rainforest. To reach your accommodation you will take a one-hour motorized canoe ride up the Tambopata River

Day 03: Full day jungle program

Day 04: Our Amazon tour ends with an early departure downriver to the airport of Puerto Maldonado for the short flight to Cusco. Afternoon sightseeing

Day 05: This morning, your Peru travels take you on a guided walking tour through the colorful markets of Cusco, the colonial cathedral and Koricancha, the impressive Temple of the Sun

Day 06: Embark on a day-long guided excursion through the Andean countryside of the legendary Sacred Valley. Overnight at Ollantaytambo
